TAX REDUCTION

FOR PRIVATE DONORS PAYING THEIR TAXES IN FRANCE : YOUR DONATION WILL INTITLE YOU TO A TAX REDUCTION

- On income tax : off up to 66% of the donation and within the limit of 20% of your taxable revenue. A donation of 100 € = 66 € of tax reduction.

- On wealth tax : up to **75%** within the limit of 50 000 €. This limit is reached for a donation of 66 666 €. A donation of 100 € = 75 € of tax reduction.

FOR BUSINESSES : tax reduction of 60% of the donation, within the limits of 5% of their turnover. A donation of 500 euros = 300 euros of tax reduction.

The municipality of Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat, in partnership with La Fondation du Patrimoine, is appealing for donations to save Saint-Hospice Chapel.

HISTORY

The Tip of Cap-Ferrat, called « tip of Saint Hospice », is named after a saint called Hospitius who, in the VIth century, lived a hermite's life in a ruined tower located on the east side of the Cap Ferrat.

The oldest mention of Saint Hospice's church, built next to the tower, dates back to 1075. The local fishermen were very attached to the cult of Saint Hospice, to whom various miraculous recoveries were attributed.



Centuries later, in 1615, the Chapel is situated at the centre of a fort built by Charles-Emmanuel 1st of Savoie to protect the population from attacks during the attempted invasion by the French.

In 1655, the Chapel is extended and bestowed with an altar, thus giving it the appearance it has today. For many centuries, it was an important pilgrimage site.

The Chapel is damaged during the Revolutionary period, it is only in 1826 that it becomes a place of worship again. In 1903 an imposing 11 meter 40 high bronze statue representing the Virgin mother holding baby Jesus is placed next to the tower of Saint Hospice. A few years later, the statue is moved next to the Chapel. The Chapel contains some paintings by Louis Marchand des Raux, which represent the life and miracles of Saint-Hospice.

The Chapel has been listed as a historical monument since 1929.



THE RESTORATION PROJECT

The town wishes to restore and conserve Saint-Hospice Chapel.



After the restoration of the Chapel, the town of Saint-Jean-Cap-ferrat would like to organize cultural exhibitions as well as musical events such as recitals and classical music concerts.

The Chapel will also be added to the guided tour « *Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat, history and legend* ». Local residents and tourists will be able to fully enjoy the restored Chapel.
